WHAT IS LITERATURE?

Hello, everyone! Literature has always been a part of our life. It is an expression of human's life, emotion, and creativity, and in return, it nurtures our life. In this first unit, we will review our understanding of the three major literary genres and identify the different nature of each.

Do I Know?

It is not easy to answer the question "What is Literature?". No single definition of literature can satisfy everyone. Literature is a cultural product of a society. Literature is also produced as an expression of human feelings, thoughts, and experiences.

The word Literature is originated from the Latin word *littera*, which means "a letter of the alphabet", hence it is "humankind's entire body of writing" (Rexroth, 2019). Does it mean anything written may be called literature and all literature is in written form?

The aforementioned definition of literature excludes the "oral literature" or "the literature of preliterate peoples" (Rexroth, 2019). It, hence, excludes folktales and some other kinds of traditional literature
